BARROW CEMETERY

THE FEES, PAYMENTS AND SUMS set out below apply:

Where the person to be interred or in respect of whom the right is granted is, or immediately before the death, was, an inhabitant or parishioner of the Parish of Barrow, or

In the case of a still-born child, where the parents (or one of them) are, at the time of interment were, such inhabitants or parishioners.

In all other cases the fees, payments and sums will be doubled except where the exclusive right of burial in the grave in question was acquired at the single fee as set out in Part 2.

PART 1 INTERMENTS

(The FEES indicated for the various headings do not include the digging of the grave)

1. For any interment in a grave:

- (i) of the body of a still-born child or of a child whose age at the time of death did not exceed sixteen years ... nil
- (ii) of the body of a person whose age at the time of death exceeded sixteen years ... £96.00
- 2 For the interment of cremated remains in a grave in respect of which an Exclusive Right of Burial has been granted ... £59.00

PART II EXCLUSIVE RIGHTS OF BURIAL IN EARTHEN GRAVES

- 1. For the exclusive right of burial in an earthen grave eight feet by four feet ... £128.00
- 2. For the exclusive right of burial of cremated Remains in an earthen grave two feet by two feet ... £84.00

PART III GRAVESTONES, TABLETS AND MONUMENTAL INSCRIPTIONS

For the right to erect or place on a grave in respect of which the exclusive right of burial has been granted:

(iii)	an iron or wooden cross	 £39.00
