

	Jo Howard queried her understanding of what was said at the APM re the	
	site for the NHP. She thought that Cllr Ford had said that 'it was a personal	
	choice between the 2 sites' Unable to verify as the minutes for the AGM	
	were not available until the next AGM and Cllr Ford had sent his apologies	
	Question: Will the NHP be visited every few years?	
	Cllr Pearson stated yes, but not the whole process. Eg Govt policy of	
	abandonment of housing targets would make us vulnerable without a current	
	NHP. It is better to have target numbers and revisit the NHP from time to	
	time.	
	Question: When will the referendum be?	
	At this stage we are not sure. Cllr Rawlings went through the process (see	
	attached notes)	
	an a subject that the referendum will be well publicised:	
	Cllr Pearson reassured the public that the referendum will be well publicised;	
	the process will be transparent and will be led by the consultants.	
	Cllr Rawlings reiterated that the PC wants the whole village to be engaged,	
	not just the interested few.	
	Cllr Pearson reiterated that the NHP is not just about planning housing -	
	there are many other aspects of the village that will be part of the NHP.

	the Village Hall – cars are parking on the path not just the verge.

6387	Councillors to sign the acceptance of office; Cllrs Bragg, Wesley and France have not done this. They do not have the forms; Cllr Pearson will ensure that they do.	
6388	No County Councillor present	
6389	 Highways: a) Update: Station Road Little Saxnam – diversion via Westiy; road closed 17th – 21st July for ditching and drainage. b) Grass Verges – there are substantial areas that WSC are responsible for; they only cut verges two times per year; we have just had no mow May which has left the verges very overgrown and possibly dangerous on some junctions. Cifr Pearson will contact WSC to discuss the issue. c) Road closure 404645 is now complete and road now open d) Road Traffic Near Miss – although Woodland View verge is not the responsibility of the PC, it has been arranged for that verge to be mowed by our contractors following complaints. 	
6390	Apologies offered for missing the AGM. Report attached. Cllr Houlder did promise to reserve his whole annual budget for the PC in order to help with NHP expenses.	
6391	Suffolk Archives - Western Way Development In 2025, Suffolk Archives are planning to move from their current premises to a new development in Bury St Edmunds where they will be co-located alongside other health, leisure, and community services They are planning to hold a short informal workshop on the morning of Wednesday 21st June The workshop will be held at their current branch premises at 77 Raingate Street in Bury St Edmunds.	
6392	Appointment of New Parish Clerk Clir Pearson announced that we have appointed a new parish Clerk to start in mid-June. She will be spending a period of time shadowing Kat; there is training available to get her qualified. There will be a period of double salary for 2 clerks.	
6393	Co-opting New Councillor – no one has yet committed	
6394	Neighbourhood Plan Report Cilir Rawlings presented his report. See attached Cilir Rawlings proposed that the date for the next meeting be pushed back to 17th July to allow WSC time to consider the report. Proposed by Cilir Holmes; seconded by Cilir Bragg. It is important that we get the NHP adopted before WSC get their local plan	
	adopted in 2025. Clir Rawlings and Clir Pearson held a meeting with the planning department of WSC today (5 th June) . it would seem that they are still backing the Bury Road site. They did however refute the suggestion by	



	one developer that they would start the development in 2024; no development can take place until the local plan has been published.	
	Cllr France asked if the draft report would be circulated prior to the meeting – Cllr Rawlings confirmed that it would.	
	Cllr Pearson stated that there needs to be sufficient time for discussion; next meeting would need a short agenda.	
6395	Land at Colethorpe Lane There has been a slight misunderstanding (see correspondence); but Cllr Pearson has cleared up any misunderstandings.	
6396	Correspondence re NHP One resident felt that the site on Barrow would result in a linear development; Cllr Pearson commented that if you take the memorial as the centre of the village, the Bury Road site and Barrow Hill site are both about the same distance; however, the site at Colethorpe Lane does not fall into that parameter.	
	Cllr France felt that the site near the school would remove the need for car parking; assuming that everyone has children!	
	We cannot put Colethorpe Lane into the NHP as WSC have deferred that site.	
	Cllr Holmes felt that the Colethorpe site would have so many benefits for the school.	
6397	Police Report See attached report In response to Cllr Rawlings request for speed monitors to be held in Colethorpe Lane – the Police stated that it was too dangerous to stop people on that road as there is no where that they can pull cars in.	
	Cllr France stated that there is no need to stop if they can record licence plates and speed.	
	Cllr Holmes stated that the Police have said they are setting up a system to take photos and record information	
6398	Community Infrastructure We have placed an order for a mixed waste bin to replace the dog bin on Watson Way.	
6399	20's Plenty There is a campaign to reduce the speeds in villages; there was unanimous support for this; Cllr Wesley felt that especially around the pinch-point at the shop. Cllr France agreed to follow this up.	Cllr
6400	Access via the Green Express House have written to the PC to ask permission to use the track on the green for access to their house and to make the track more solid; stated suitable material; all waste to be removed by the contractor; Cllr Pearson approved; proposed by Cllr Wesley; seconded by Cllr Holmes
